

- 1 Pray for the work of The Source with troubled young people; for Richard the Director and their ministries with the café, 'Real' groups, anger management, mentoring and the work with teenage mothers, and ask God's strength for all staff and volunteers as well as or more funding and the right person to ret office space in their building.
- 2 Praise God for who He is and all He is doing and seek His blessing on our gatherings in His Name today, and especially for Daisy and the family as she is dedicated.
- 3 Pray for the team of youth as they set off for Mission Manchester today; for safe travelling and a fruitful and formative week. Pray also that the PPP will be a priority for many and that we will engage well in prayer and in hearing His voice.
- 4 Keep praying for those who are housebound or long-term ill, including Madge, Win, Peter and Janet, Pat, John, Joan, and Nicky. Pray also for those who care. Pray for those who mourn, that they will be comforted.
- 5 Pray for the first of the Cluster gatherings for August this evening at the Church of the Ascension, and pray for Tom as curate-in-charge there. Keep praying for Mission Manchester, the youth and leaders and the churches they are working with.
- 6 Pray for Kingsley Court opposite church and for the Communion there this morning; ask God to draw people there to Himself before it is too late. Praise God for the witness of the Christians who live in Kingsley Court and other retirement places and pray that their light will shine brightly.
- 7 Pray for the more 'ethnic' congregations that meet at Trinity, for the NACC (Zimbabwean church) as they meet in the Hall each Sunday, and for the Indian fellowship meeting Sunday afternoons in Crossover.
- 8 Pray for work to be done soon around the building – on the baptistery and on the new glass doors at the two main entrances to and from Crossover and pray for no hitches with the 'red tape'!
- 9 Seek the Lord's blessing as we gather in His name to worship Him and ask that we are all built up in Him and become more like Jesus. Pray also for our finances at Trinity and for those helping manage that side of things, especially Joyce, Jan and Susan - the Treasury Team.
- 10 Pray for those living at Place Court and for George leading a Communion there this morning. Pray God's blessing on Aldershot Churches Together and for the leaders of each of the churches.
- 11 Pray for Sheaf and Grace ministering in India, for KC Deva Raju and for his family, the seventy churches and pastors and for the work amongst the poor and disadvantaged.
- 12 Pray for the midweek Communion each Wednesday that it will nourish spiritually those who come and will draw in new folk. Also, ask God's blessing on the Cluster gathering at Trinity tonight and for George leading it.
- 13 Pray for the Soul Sisters Nature Walk today; for good weather, good fellowship and good conversations. Pray also for each of the MAGNet groups and a real blessing on all the men who are part of them.
- 14 Pray for a special time at the church barbecue and social this evening that we will have fun and engage well together as a church family. Pray for the work of Ursula and Jos in Nepal and for their break in the UK, and for Ursula's health. Pray also for Anwer's family in Pakistan and for Matt and Mel and the work of Kids Alive.
- 15 Ask the Lord to give clear guidance to the 11.15 team meeting this morning to plan for the future of that congregation, both on Sundays and midweek.
- 16 Invoke the Lord's name as you pray for the services today and all those taking part, that we may be renewed in our worship and service of Him, and seek God's kingdom power for the healing service at 9.30. Ask God's blessing on the J-Men barbecue at lunchtime.
- 17 Ask God's special blessing for all those going to Soul Survivor today; for safe journeys and many spiritual breakthroughs and times of refreshing over the week ahead.
- 18 Intercede for the people who will be moving into the new flats at the top of Victoria Road and Union Street, as well as those across Victoria Road, and for folk to visit when that happens.
- 19 Pray for the Cluster gathering this evening at St Augustine's and pray for the church there and for their vicar, Keith.
- 20 Keep holding before God those at Soul Survivor and pray for those who get important exam results today and next week.
- 21 Pray for the Vine, as they work with the homeless locally; for those running it, for all the volunteers there and on the M&S run, and for sufficient funding. Pray also for the New Life Bookshop, a resource for Christians, and for Keith running it. Pray also for our website and Steve managing it and for the effect of our signboards and for

inspiration for more and for other forms of publicity.

- 22 Pray for the work we do with older folk and in homes and pray for those who visit the lonely, sick and bereaved, especially Dave (and for Sandra's full recovery). Pray too for Joan, Dawn and Rosemary as Pastoral Assistants and for all they do as the Pastoral Team.
- 23 Ask God to fill you with His Spirit and that our services will be Spirit-filled in every way. Pray for the Worship and Tech Teams, that they may be further equipped creatively and spiritually.
- 24 Intercede for Songs of Rage reaching out to the music culture at the West End Centre and for their planning for the future. And for Arthur and Christine compiling Update at this time and every month.
- 25 Pray for our wardens in all they do, often behind the scenes, and for those who serve practically, like those who clean the brass, the coffee teams, the catering team, flower ladies and for our Readers and others on so many rotas etc.
- 26 Pray for the last of the Cluster gatherings at St. Michael's and pray for the church there and for James their vicar.
- 27 Pray for two people in your sphere of contact who don't yet know Jesus and ask the Lord to lead you to appropriate opportunities to witness to them.
- 28 Ask God to bring a real anointing for the Town Centre Pastoral Team as they meet so many people in town, for Gwen doing the administration and that many more will join up. Pray for the prayer meeting tonight and the outreaches this weekend.

- 29 Pray for our NSM staff; for Moira in all she does and in her pregnancy, and for John in his early months of ordained ministry. Pray also for our Readers, Jean, Carol and Robert and those recently licensed to preach (Tat, Steve and Tayo).
- 30 Pray for today's services and for the Lord's powerful touch at each. Pray for any who are new and ask God's blessing for the Welcome Team.
- 31 Pray for a good time of relaxation for those not working today. Pray also for those who have to work today or on other Bank Holidays and weekends (eg doctors, nurses, police); pray by name for those you know.

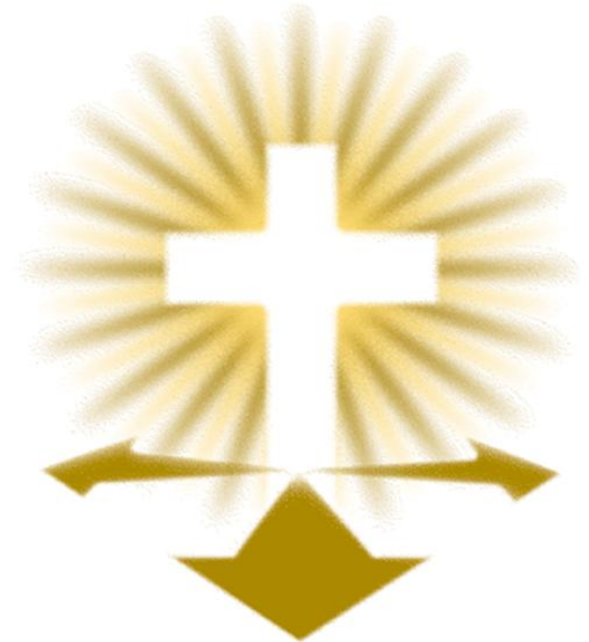
