**ISAIAH 61:1-4**

1 *'The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me . . .'* Ask God to fill you afresh with His Spirit.

**Pray a special blessing for Jonathan today and for the planning meeting for the J Men F1 night.**

2 *'... He has anointed me...'* Ask the Lord to anoint you afresh with His power for what He has called you to.

**Pray for the Town Centre Pastoral Team as they meet and get some training this evening, and for all the ongoing outreach in the day, night, late night and with the dream stall.**

3 *'...to preach the good news...'* Ask the Lord to enable you to share with confidence the great news of Jesus.

**Pray for an enjoyable time of friendship, fellowship, and fun at this evening's Harvest Supper and for all taking part.**

4 Praise God for who He is, all His bounteous provision and all He is doing and seek His blessing on our gatherings in His Name today for our Harvest services, and especially for our speakers from CMS A Rocha.

5 *'...to the poor...'* As we recognise everyone without Jesus is 'poor' spiritually and eternally, pray for some people you know who don't yet know Him. Pray also that the PPP will be a priority for many and that we will engage well in prayer and in hearing Him.

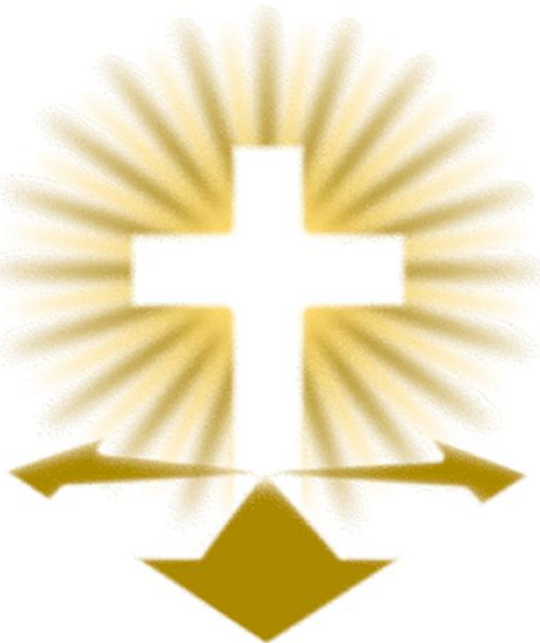
6 *'.. the poor...'* Pray for the work of The Source with troubled young people; for Richard the Director and their ministries with the café, 'Real' groups, anger management, mentoring and the work with teenage mothers, and ask God's strength for all staff and volunteers as well as for more funding.

7 *... to bind up the broken hearted...'* Pray for the Pastoral Team and all who minister to those hurting. **Pray too for the day conference at Trinity and for the Alpha Course looking at the cross.**

8 *'... to proclaim freedom for the captives...'* Pray for all those bound up in addictive behaviour and pray for those ministering to them. **Pray also for the meeting with the Fleet Town Centre Team, Communion at Kingsley Court, asking God's special blessing on all these, and for the 11.15 team meeting to plan key things for next year.**

9 *'... and release from darkness...'* Recognising that the enemy keeps people in the dark, resist him as you submit to God and pray for those still walking in darkness. **Keep praying for those who are housebound or long-term ill, including Madge, Win, Peter and Janet, Pat, John, Joan and Nicky. Pray also for those who care.**

10 *'... for the prisoners...'* pray for those who minister in prisons, Alpha in prisons and for those in prison. **Pray for the other congregations that meet at Trinity, for the NACC (Zimbabwean church) as they meet in the Hall each Sunday, and for the Indian fellowship meeting Sunday afternoons in Crossover and for clarity as**

**11** Seek the Lord's blessing as we gather in His name to worship Him and ask that we are all built up in Him and become more like Jesus. Pray for the Healing service at 9.30 and for the two families coming for Dedications after the main services, that God will speak and call them. Pray also for our finances at Trinity and for Joyce and Jan helping manage that side of things.

16 '*... to bestow on them a crown...*' Praise God for His provisions and blessings in this life and the next. Today, pray hard for a great time at the big J Men F1 event, for all those taking part and setting up, for all guests and for the input.

21 '*... a garment of praise ...*' Ask God to give you a heart to praise Him and to give thanks in all circumstances. Pray for the work of Jos with INF in Nepal and for Ursula here, and for Ursula's health. Pray also for Anwer's family in Pakistan and for Matt and Mel and the work of Kids Alive. Pray for Alpha.

12 '*... to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour...*' Ask that those who have a negative view of God will recognise His immense love and 'favour' towards them. Pray for unity and numbers out as we gather for the ACT time of prayer for the town at KC21.

17 '*... beauty instead of ashes...*' pray for those burnt out, tired or with a very negative self image, that they will have and know the radiant beauty of God in them. Pray for Mark and Sam getting married today and pray for Sheaf and Grace ministering in India, for KC Deva Raju (especially his health) and for his family, the churches, pastors and for the work amongst the poor and disadvantaged.

22 '*... instead of a spirit of despair ...*' Pray for those who see no hope, that they will know the God of all hope and see a way ahead. Intercede for the people who will be moving into the new flats at the top of Victoria Road and Union Street, as well as those across Victoria Road, and for folk to visit when that happens. Pray for George tutoring his IME group all day.

13 '*... and the day of vengeance of our God...*' With so many having questions/objections about Hell, ask God to help you know this reality and motivate you to help people see the wonderful alternative. Pray for work to be done soon around the building – on the baptistery and on the new glass doors at the two main entrances to and from Crossover and pray for no hitches with the 'red tape'!

18 Invoke the Lord's name as you pray for the services today and all those taking part, that we may be renewed in our worship and service of Him, and pray for the Worship and Tech Teams meeting and practising afterwards.

23 '*... They will be called oaks of righteousness ...*' Pray for a real strength from God and that you may put deep spiritual roots down in Him. Pray for the ministers of the churches meeting together for the day, and keep praying for those on Alpha.

14 '*... to comfort all who mourn...*' Ask God's blessing for those who have lost loved ones, for George taking funerals and for Dave and others following up.

19 '*... the oil of gladness ...*' Seek the Lord's joy in your life to strengthen you and bless others. Pray for the Fellowship Groups and their leaders as they meet this evening and for clarity in making plans. And for Arthur and Christine compiling Update at this time and every month.

24 '*... a planting for the Lord ...*' Pray that you will grow more and more in Him and like Him. Pray for the Vine and for the New Life Bookshop. Pray also for our website and for our sign boards.

15 '*... to provide for those who grieve...*' Again pray for our ministry to those who have lost loved ones and that they will know God's provision of comfort, strength and peace. Pray for the midweek Communion each

**Pray for our NSM staff; for Moira in all she does and in her pregnancy, and for John in his early months of ordained ministry. Pray also for our Readers, Jean, Carol and Robert and those recently licensed to preach.**

**Pray for God's renewing in our town.**
