- 1 Pray that many will be able to come to the PPP this evening, that we may commit all the activities of the month into His hands and that we will know His will and guidance for the future. ***"Prayer is the breath of faith. Prayer meetings are the lungs of the church."***
- 2 Pray for Songs of Rage as they meet for fellowship and regularly reach out to the West End Centre, especially for John, Pete and John leading.
- 3 Pray for our midweek Communion every Wednesday and for good fellowship and renewal there. Pray for the C.U.s at Farnborough College today. Pray especially for the last session of training for the POD Group Leaders.
- 4 Pray for Women's Hour and for all who lead and attend, as well as their speakers. Pray also for the local clergy lunching together.
- 5 Pray for Ursula and Jos, now back permanently in the UK. Ask that God will help them in settling back and guide them in ministry here. Pray hard for the J-Men beer and skittles outreach event tonight and for each of the men that come and the input.
- 6 Pray for the MAGNET Groups for men; that they will function well and help foster a greater measure of God's purity and power. Pray for Bert Hurrell - 90 today! And ask God's blessing on the LLL marriage/relationship course today.

- 7 Seek the Lord's blessing and presence with us, as we gather at the services this morning. Pray for all those helping or leading services, as well as for each one who attends, that we are all renewed in worship, prayer, unity and the Word. Pray also for the Growing Leaders Youth buffet.
- 8 Pray for the ACT time of prayer for Aldershot this evening at KC21, for a good attendance and for growing unity that leads to transformational action in the town. Pray also for George leading the service at Place Court today.
- 9 Pray for those who are housebound or long-term ill, including Madge, Lily, Win, Peter and Janet, Pat, Iris, and Nicky & pray for those who care.
- 10 Petition the Lord for unity and blessing as the clergy of the Chapter gather over lunch and pray for all the churches that serve the town and deanery. Be praying for the POD groups as they start to meet.
- 11 Pray for Contact meeting each Thursday and for all the mums and children, as well as Mary, Ann-Marie and Di leading it.
- 12 Pray for clear guidance towards creating a chaplaincy service to the Health Centre and other NHS surgeries and clinics in Aldershot and for doors to open as we negotiate and for the Lord to provide all the necessary resources.
- 13 Pray for the Prayer Ministry Team meeting today and their ministry after services, and on the streets.

- 14 As we gather in His name to worship, pray and receive His word in the fellowship of His Son, pray that we all are built up in the likeness of Christ. Pray also for all marriages and for those preparing for marriage and our marriage preparation team.
- 15 Ask for the Lord's guidance and unity in our 'staff meeting'; that His hand will guide all discussions and decisions. Pray that the plans for the baptistery and glass doors will proceed into action soon.
- 16 Pray for the Vine, as they work with the homeless locally. Pray for the New Life Bookshop in its final months, and for Keith running it. Pray also for all the work at The Source with troubled young people and especially for enough funding. Also, seek the Lord's guidance and commit to Him what you plan to do over Lent, starting tomorrow.
- 17 As Lent starts, pray that you may make strong choices and grow in godliness and self-control, as you make sacrifices for Him in your daily life. Pray for all the POD groups starting up and their leaders.
- 18 Pray for the site at Trinity, often difficult, expensive and time consuming to maintain. Pray for the cleaners, Jax, our site manager and gardener, also for someone to take over overseeing building work from Peter. Pray also for the service at Kingsley Court.
- 19 Pray for the Soul Sisters Mama Mia 70s film evening, for all to go well, for lots of people to come and for good conversations that lead ladies towards Christ.
- 20 Pray for the Recession Response Team, for guidance as to whether to take the Being Moneywise course out to the wider town. And ask God to bless and guide the 11.15 Service Team meeting today. Pray too for the Praying Wives.
- 21 Pray for a special blessing as we gather together in our congregations today, and pray for all those leading and taking part. Give thanks and pray for all those who help and lead in any way and pray for an ongoing renewal in our worship, preaching, prayer and fellowship.
- 22 Pray for our Rural Dean, David, our Archdeacon, Stuart and our Bishops, Christopher and Ian. Pray for the Fellowship Group Leaders meeting tonight. Pray also for Dave and Sandra, Joan, Dawn and Rosemary, our Pastoral Assistants here at Trinity; and pray for the Pastoral Team to be a help and blessing to many in all circumstances.
- 23 Pray for Arthur and Christine as they compile and edit Update every month. Pray for the rest of our publicity; the sign boards and inspiration for new ones, and for the website and pray for Steve managing that. Keep praying for the PODs.
- 24 Keep praying for the work and ministry of The Larder and for those visited and those visiting, that they will take something of the love of Christ with them. Pray today for two people you know who do not, as yet, know and follow the Lord Jesus and ask both for the Spirit to convict them and for opportunities to witness to them.
- 25 Pray for George leading the IME group of curates today. Pray also for Sheaf and Grace ministering in India, for KC Deva Raju, for his health and his family, the seventy churches and pastors and for the work amongst the poor and disadvantaged.
- 26 Pray for the ongoing work of the Town Centre Pastoral Team, for tonight's meeting, for all those going out, for funding, for all those who open up and are prayed for; that it will bring lasting transformation to many and to the town. Pray for our Wardens, Paul and Martyn in all they do, and for the 20s/30s group seeking the Lord for the best way ahead to reach out to that age group.
- 27 Ask the Lord to strengthen and sustain all directly affected by the recession, and that those who know Him will know His strength and hope. Pray for Rob doing his gap-year placement with us, that he will grow in strength in the Lord and for Tom and Sarah in their Gap year projects. Pray also for the second session of the LLL course.
- 28 Pray for a tangible sense of God's presence as we gather, worship and hear God's word at church, and pray for new folk to join us. Pray also for our finances at Trinity, which are not in as good a place as they could be, and for those helping manage that side of things, especially the Treasury Team.
