March '10 Prayer Leaflet

Father, take us and use us.

Fill us with your Spirit;

That, knowing your love,

We will show it through our lives,

And share it with those around us;

throughout Aldershot.

- 1 Pray that many will be able to come to the PPP this evening, that we may commit all the activities of the month into His hands and that we will know His will and guidance for the future.
- 2 Pray for George doing a presentation to Rowan Williams today and pray that his day in the diocese will be helpful and fruitful.
- 3 Pray for our midweek Communion every Wednesday and for good fellowship and renewal there. Pray for the Christian Unions for staff and students at Farnborough College today.
- 4 Pray for Women's Hour and for all who lead and attend, as well as their speakers. Pray also for each of the PODs now launched as they work towards their first 'App.'
- 5 Pray for Ursula and Jos; that God will help them in settling back and guide them in ministry here. Ask the Lord's blessing on Friendly, each Friday; for the leaders and helpers as well as for the children to be drawn to the Lord.
- 6 Pray for the MAGNET Groups for men; that they will function well and help foster a greater measure of God's purity and power. Pray for George and Carol at Diocesan Synod all day.
- 7 Seek the Lord's blessing and presence with us, as we gather at the services this morning. Pray for all those helping or leading services, as well as for each one who attends, that we are all renewed in worship, prayer, unity and the Word.
- 8 Pray for the ACT time of prayer for Aldershot this evening at KC21, for a good attendance and for growing unity that leads to transformational action in the town.
- 9 Pray for those who are housebound or long-term ill, including Madge, Win, Peter and Janet, Pat, Iris, and Nicky & pray for those who care.
- 10 Pray for the New Life Bookshop entering its final month; thank the Lord for Keith running it and pray for His guidance and provision for him as he moves on.
- 11 Pray for Contact meeting each Thursday and for all the mums and children, as well as Mary, Ann-Marie and Di leading it.
- 12 Pray for clear guidance towards creating a chaplaincy service to the Health Centre and other NHS surgeries and clinics in Aldershot and for doors to open as we negotiate and for the Lord to provide all the necessary resources.
- 13 Pray for the Men's breakfast this morning; for good fellowship, a good time of prayer and clear vision.
- 14 As we gather in His name to worship, pray and receive His word in the fellowship of His Son, pray that we all are built up in the likeness of Christ. Pray also for all mothers and families.
- 15 Ask for the Lord's guidance and unity in the PCC meeting; that His hand will guide all discussions and decisions. Pray that the plans for the baptistery and glass doors will proceed into action soon.

- 16 Pray for the Vine, as they work with the homeless locally. Pray also for all the work at The Source with troubled young people and especially for enough funding. We have had contact with a number of nearly homeless folk recently considering Alpha – pray they will be able to find the Lord and build a solid foundation for their lives.
- 17 With the bishop in the deanery this week, ask God to bless him and that this week will be beneficial. Pray especially for the meeting about reaching and resourcing the Nepalese community this evening.
- 18 Pray for the site at Trinity, often difficult, expensive and time consuming to maintain. Pray for the cleaners Rob and James, Jax, our site manager and Carol, the gardener, also for someone to take over overseeing building work from Peter. Pray also for the service at Kingsley Court and the Chapter meeting.
- 19 Pray for the planning meeting towards getting the big tent mission going in the late summer, and for the bishop joining the TCPT tonight!
- 20 Pray for the LLL marriage course finishing today, and ask God to enrich each of the marriages represented on the course.
- 21 Pray for a special blessing as we gather together in our congregations this Passion Sunday; that we may see clearly the cross of Christ. Ask God's continuing blessing on the Youth Growing Leaders course as they meet this evening.
- 22 Pray for Dave and Sandra, Joan, Dawn, Jacqui and Rosemary, our Pastoral Assistants here at Trinity; and pray for the Pastoral Team to be a help and blessing to many in all circumstances.
- 23 Pray for Arthur and Christine as they compile and edit Update every month. Pray for the rest of our publicity; the sign boards and inspiration for new ones, and for the website and pray for Steve managing that. Keep praying for the PODs.
- 24 Ask God's blessing on the assemblies in various schools this week, that the gospel will bring God's salvation to many; pray for the team and their 'performances' and a continuing open door in both junior and secondary schools. Pray today for two people you know who do not, as yet, know and follow the Lord Jesus and ask both for the Spirit to convict them and for opportunities to witness to them.
- 25 Pray for Sheaf and Grace ministering in India, for KC Deva Raju, for his health and his family, the seventy churches and pastors and for the work amongst the poor and disadvantaged. Also, ask God's help for Kids Alive and Matt Parker, especially in their work in Haiti.
- 26 Pray for the ongoing work of the Town Centre Pastoral Team, for tonight's meeting, for all those going out, for funding, for all those who open up and are prayed for; that it will bring lasting transformation to many and to the town. Ask God to provide town centre premises in His time. Pray for our Wardens, Paul and Martyn in all they do.
- 27 Ask the Lord to strengthen and sustain all directly affected by the recession, and that those who know Him will know His strength and hope. Pray for Rob doing his gap-year placement with us, that he will grow in strength in the Lord and for Tom and Sarah in their Gap year projects. Also pray for the Prayer Ministry Team meeting this morning and for their equipping and empowering.
- 28 Pray for a tangible sense of God's presence as we gather, worship and hear God's word at church, and pray for the speaker, Heather, from Bible Society, that she will speak clearly and powerfully (and don't forget the clocks go forward!)
- 29 Pray for our finances at Trinity which are not in as good a place as they could be, and for those helping manage that side of things, especially the Treasury Team.
- 30 Pray for the Easter publicity; that it will all be distributed and will draw many to church and to the Lord. Keep praying for the work and ministry of The Larder and for those visited and those visiting, that they will take something of the love of Christ with them.
- 31 Spend a moment focussing on the way of the cross as you choose to follow Him who endured so much for us.
