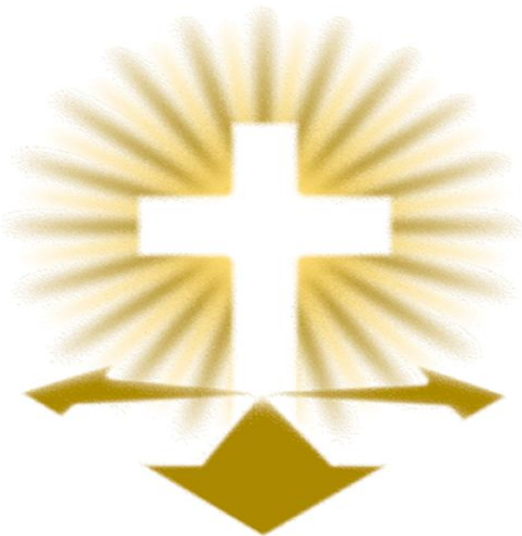

## ***April '10 Prayer Leaflet***

**Father, take us and use us.**

**Fill us with your Spirit;**

**That, knowing your love,**

**We will show it through our lives,**

**And share it with those around us;**

**That Jesus will be known**

**throughout Aldershot.**

- 1 This Maundy Thursday, as we reflect on the Last Supper, the institution of Communion and the journey Jesus took towards the cross, pray that the services and meditations in the afternoon and evening will help focus many on Him. Pray for the distribution and effect of our newsletters.
- 2 This Good Friday, focus on the cross afresh and thank God for giving us Jesus. Pray for the impact of the walk in town with the big cross and that the meditations in the afternoon will draw many and touch the depths of our spirits.
- 3 Pray for Tony and Mohammad being confirmed at the Cathedral this evening and for the last minute preparations for Easter.
- 4 Praise the Lord for the resurrection of Jesus and pray that we will know His transforming power and presence in our gatherings today, including our PPP.
- 5 Pray for those who are housebound or long-term ill, including Madge, Win, Peter and Janet, Pat, Iris, Margaret, and Nicky & pray for those who care.
- 6 Pray for the Vine, as they work with the homeless locally and for openings to run Alpha there at lunchtimes. Pray also for all the work at The Source with troubled young people and for enough funding.
- 7 Pray for Sheaf and Grace ministering in India, for KC Deva Raju, for his health and his family, the seventy churches and pastors and for the work amongst the poor. Also, ask God's help for Kids Alive and Matt, especially in their work in Haiti.
- 8 Pray for Women's Hour and for all who lead and attend, as well as their speakers. Pray also for each of the PODs as they are into their second cycle.
- 9 Pray for any who have heard and understood the gospel over Easter, that they may choose to follow Jesus. Pray for our finances at Trinity which are not in as good a place as they could be, and for those helping manage that side of things, especially the Treasury Team.
- 10 Pray for the Key Staff Day Away today, that this will be a day of deepening vision and prayer together and of receiving guidance from God.
- 11 Seek the Lord's blessing and presence with us, as we gather at the services this morning. Pray for all those helping or leading services, as well as for each one who attends, that we are all renewed in worship, prayer, unity and the Word. Pray also for the Youth Growing Leaders meeting tonight and for all the youth, leaders and mentors.
- 12 Pray for the ACT service at Place Court this morning and the time of prayer for Aldershot this evening at KC21, for a good attendance and for growing unity that leads to transformational action in the town.
- 13 Pray for the New Life Bookshop in its final few weeks; thank the Lord for Keith running it and pray for His guidance and provision for him as he moves on.
- 14 Pray for the ministers meeting for prayer this morning; for deep unity and fellowship in their struggles and a powerful time of prayer.

- 15 Pray for the service at Kingsley Court today and for the clergy of Aldershot meeting over lunch. Pray also for the site at Trinity, often difficult, expensive and time consuming to maintain. Pray for the cleaners Rob and James, Jax, our site manager and Carol, the gardener, also for someone to take over overseeing building work from Peter Blake.
- 16 Pray for the Band of Brothers men's weekend away starting today; for growing fellowship and for the Lord to do a deep work, as well as for fun and safety in all the activities.
- 17 Pray for clear guidance towards creating a chaplaincy service to the Health Centre and other NHS surgeries and clinics in Aldershot and for doors to open as we negotiate and for the Lord to provide all the necessary resources.
- 18 As we gather in His name to worship, pray and receive His word in the fellowship of His Son, pray that we all are built up in the likeness of Christ.
- 19 Ask God's blessing on a tutorial George is taking at Farnborough College and that the POD Leaders meeting tonight will be helpful and equipping.
- 20 Pray that the plans for the baptistery, further railings and glass doors will proceed into action soon.
- 21 Pray for a positive time of review, worship, vision and prayer at the AGM tonight and pray for those who will be elected to PCC and as Wardens.
- 22 Pray for Contact meeting each Thursday and for all the mums and children, as well as Mary, Ann-Marie and Di leading it. Pray for George leading the IME group of curates.
- 23 Ask the Lord's blessing on Friendzy, each Friday; for the leaders and helpers as well as for the children to be drawn to the Lord. Pray also for all those in the Army, especially those serving in Afghanistan; for their protection and that good will prevail over evil there and peace won. Pray also for clear direction in linking with the Nepalese community.
- 24 Pray for the women's seminar in church today; for good numbers, for the speaker and for all to know a fresh blessing or insight from God. Pray also for the MAGNET Groups for men; that they will function well and help foster a greater measure of God's purity and power.
- 25 Pray for a special blessing as we gather together in our congregations today. Pray also for Café Church tonight, that new folk that would not normally come to a church building will be drawn in and to Him.
- 26 Pray for Dave and Sandra, Joan, Dawn, Jacqui and Rosemary, our Pastoral Assistants here at Trinity; and pray for the Pastoral Team to be a help and blessing to many in all circumstances. Pray for the youth Inclusion meeting this evening.
- 27 Pray for Arthur and Christine as they compile and edit Update every month. Pray for the rest of our publicity; the sign boards and inspiration for new ones, and for the website with Steve managing that.
- 28 Keep praying for the PODs as they come towards their second App. And for all the leaders. Keep praying for the work and ministry of The Larder and for those visited and those visiting, that they will take something of the love of Christ with them.
- 29 Ask the Lord to strengthen and sustain all directly affected by the recession, and that those who know Him will know His strength and hope. Pray for Rob doing his gap-year placement with us, that he will grow in strength in the Lord and for Tom and Sarah in their Gap year projects.
- 30 Pray for the ongoing work of the Town Centre Pastoral Team, for tonight's meeting, for all those going out, for funding, for all those who open up and are prayed for; that it will bring lasting transformation to many and to the town. Ask God to provide town centre premises in His time.
