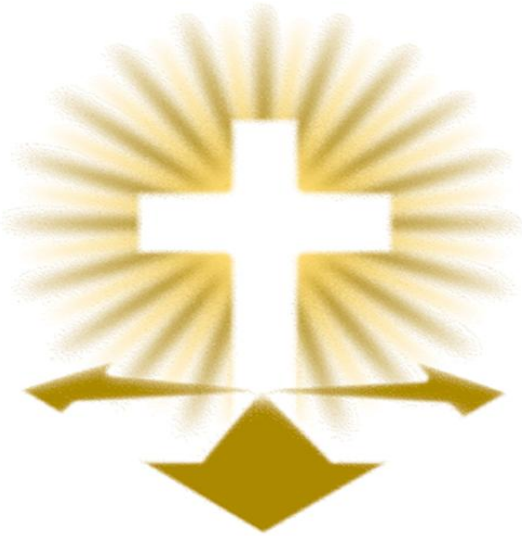

July '10 Prayer Leaflet

- 1 Pray for the assembly this morning and for the Alpha course this evening, as well as for Contact and Women's Hour today.
- 2 Pray for our new Child Protection Team, Joan, Ali and Julie, and pray for all the children's work at church and for all the leaders of the groups. Pray for the TCPT as they meet this evening and for all their outreaches.
- 3 Ask God's special blessing on John as he gets ordained 'priest' today in the cathedral and pray that it will be an uplifting service for all there.
- 4 Seek the Lord's blessing and presence with us, as we gather at the services this morning. Pray for all those helping or leading services, for each one who attends, that we are all renewed in worship, prayer, unity and the Word. Pray for those from London City Mission sharing in the services and pray for a good time at the newcomers BBQ over lunch and the Christening this afternoon.
- 5 Pray for the presence of many from Trinity, as well as of the Lord, at this evening's PPP as we celebrate good news, seek His guidance and pray in agreement according to His will and leading.
- 6 Pray for all those in the Army, especially those serving in Afghanistan; for their protection and that good will prevail over evil there and peace be won. Pray also for clear direction in linking with the Nepalese community, and ask God's help for Kids Alive and Matt Parker, especially in their work in Haiti.
- 7 Pray for our midweek Communion service and the CUs at the Tech today, and pray for the TCPT training evening on bereavement.
- 8 Pray for those who are housebound or long-term ill, including Madge, Win, Peter and Janet, Pat, Iris, Margaret, and Nicky & pray for those who care. Keep praying for Alpha near the end of the course and for guidance for those on it.
- 9 Pray for the Vine, as they work with the homeless locally and for openings to run Alpha there at lunchtimes. Pray also for all the work at The Source with troubled young people and for enough funding. Ask the Lord's blessing on Friendzy, each Friday; for the leaders and helpers, as well as for the children to be drawn to the Lord.
- 10 Pray for the second session of TCPT training on bereavement this morning. Pray also for Sheaf and Grace ministering in India, for KC Deva Raju, for his health and his family, the seventy churches and pastors and for the work amongst the poor and for his daughter getting married soon.

- 11 As we gather in His name to worship, pray and receive His word in the fellowship of His Son, pray that we all are built up in the likeness of Christ. Pray for the church picnic afterwards and for Inclusion.
- 12 Pray for the ACT time of prayer for Aldershot this evening at KC21, for a good attendance and for growing unity that leads to action. Pray too for the children's leaders meeting this evening.
- 13 Pray for our finances at Trinity which are not in as good a place as they could be, and for those helping manage that side of things, especially Joyce and Jan, the Treasury Team.
- 14 Pray for all the POD groups and Fellowship Groups, for the leaders, and positive experiences through the App.s, that they will help people to grow and discover new gifts and calling. Pray for the clergy Chapter meeting.
- 15 Pray for George speaking at the Diocesan Summer School today and for all the talks of this worthwhile venture.
- 16 Pray for the site at Trinity, often difficult, expensive and time consuming to maintain. Pray for the cleaners, Rob and James, for a new site manager and for Carol, the gardener, also for someone to take over overseeing building work from Peter Blake. Pray for the Blakes to settle well in Germany.
- 17 Pray God's blessing on the Magnet groups for men, and for guidance for the planning for the future of the men's ministry at and through Trinity.
- 18 Ask for a special and deep blessing for our services, that we all draw closer to God. Pray for Ursula being licensed as an LLM (Reader) this afternoon at the cathedral.
- 19 Pray for the PCC meeting this evening; for clarity, unity, vision and the Lord's leading in all areas.
- 20 Pray for Arthur and Christine as they compile and edit Update every month. Pray for the rest of our publicity; the sign boards and inspiration for new ones, and for the website with Steve managing that.
- 21 Pray for Dave and Sandra, Joan, Dawn, Jacquie and Rosemary, our Pastoral Assistants here at Trinity; and pray for the Pastoral Team to be a help and blessing to many in all circumstances. Pray too for the ministers of the town meeting over lunch.
- 22 Pray for all the mentoring that happens for Growing Leaders as the course draws to its conclusion, and for firm foundations for the leadership of the next generation.
- 23 Pray for the ongoing work of the Town Centre Pastoral Team as they go out in daytimes, the evenings and late nights; for good opportunities and for many to be blessed and drawn to Jesus and His healing love. Pray for the Prayer Ministry Team meeting this evening.
- 24 Pray for Sarah and Tom coming to the end of their gap years; for guidance as they follow the Lord. Pray for good weather and a good time as we gather for the church BBQ this evening.
- 25 Pray for a special blessing as we gather together in our congregations today and ask God to bless each person, from the youngest to the oldest who comes along, and for the Growing Leaders final session tonight.

- 31 Keep praying for the work and ministry of The Larder and for those visited and those visiting, that they will take something of the love of Christ with them. Pray for Rob and Gaz preparing for gap years away.
