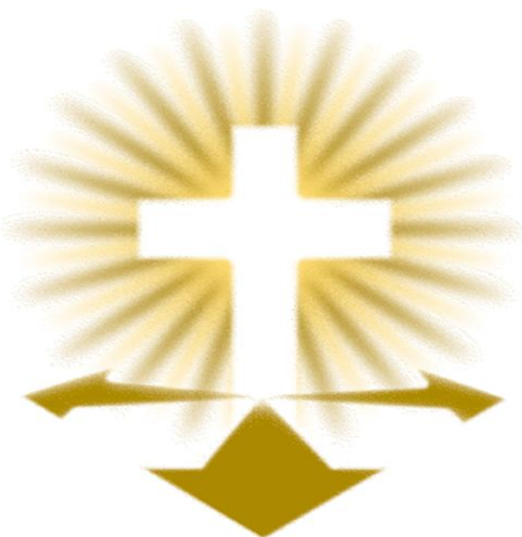

## August '10 Prayer Leaflet

- 1 Seek the Lord's blessing and presence with us, as we gather at the services this morning. Pray for all those helping or leading services, especially a POD doing the 11.15; for each one who attends to be renewed in worship, prayer, unity and the Word. Pray also for the Alpha Holy Spirit Day, that each will be able to get along and be thoroughly blessed.
- 2 Pray for the presence of many from Trinity, as well as of the Lord, at this evening's PPP as we give thanks, seek His guidance and pray in agreement according to His will and leading.
- 3 Pray for Anwer in Pakistan trying to help his persecuted family as well as several others facing danger for their faith each day over there.
- 4 Pray for the first of this month's Cluster meetings at St. Michael's, and ask the Lord that these will be good times of unity, fellowship and learning together. Pray for St. Michael's and for James their vicar.
- 5 Pray for all those in the Army, especially those serving in Afghanistan; for their protection and that good will prevail over evil there and peace be won.

- 6 Pray for clear direction in linking with the Nepalese community and pray especially for Jos and Ursula in this.
- 7 Pray for the 11.15 Team meeting this morning; for clear guidance and unity in discussion, planning and prayer. Ask God's blessing also on the quiz night at church and for funds to be raised for Gaz' gap year through it.
- 8 As we gather in His name to worship, pray and receive His word in the fellowship of His Son, pray that we all are built up in the likeness of Christ.
- 9 Pray for those going to Viney Hill, for a safe journey today and a great week of fun and adventure and for the Christian input. Pray also for George leading a Communion service at Place Court today and pray for all those less able to get out being visited over the summer with Communion.
- 10 Pray for those who are housebound or long-term ill, including Madge, Win, Peter and Janet, Pat, Iris, Margaret, and Nicky & pray for those who care.
- 11 Pray for the planning meeting for the Big Tent event next month. Keep praying for the Cluster, with the meeting tonight at St. Augustine's and with the clergy meeting for lunch tomorrow. Pray for St. Augustine's and Keith their vicar.
- 12 Pray for our Child Protection Team, Joan, Ali and Julie, and pray for all the children's work at church, including Contact today, and for all the leaders of the groups, especially those at Viney Hill this week.

- 13 Pray for the Vine, as they work with the homeless locally, currently re-located to the Baptist church, and for openings to run Alpha there at lunchtimes. Pray also for all the work at The Source with troubled young people and for enough funding to continue their good work in so many different ways.
- 14 Pray for Sheaf and Grace ministering in India, for KC Deva Raju, for his health and his family, especially his daughter Marcella getting married about this time, the seventy churches and pastors and for the work amongst the poor.
- 15 Seek the Lord's blessing and felt presence as we gather together for our services today. Pray for those on holiday at this time that they will be able to find a good church to worship with.
- 16 Pray for the large group going to Soul Survivor today; for safe journeys, for good weather and that the Lord will thoroughly bless each one through the week.
- 17 Pray for our finances at Trinity which are not in as good a place as they could be, and for those helping manage that side of things, especially Joyce and Jan, the Treasury Team.
- 18 Pray for our regular midweek congregation on Wednesday mornings and for more to join. Keep praying for all those at Soul Survivor and those leading, cooking etc. Pray for the Cluster meeting at Trinity tonight.
- 19 Pray for Contact meeting again today. Pray too for our new Buildings and Site managers, Don and Ed, and for the site at Trinity, often expensive to maintain, as well as our cleaners, Rob and James, and for Carol, the gardener. Pray also for those receiving A Level results today and for clear guidance for those making decisions about universities and the future.
- 20 Pray God's blessing on the Magnet groups for men, and for guidance for the planning for the future of the men's ministry at and through Trinity.
- 21 Pray for the wedding blessing at Trinity this morning, and pray God's blessing on all the marriages in the church.
- 22 Ask for a special and deep blessing for our services, that we all draw closer to God and pray that, as hands are laid on in the 9.30 healing service, people will be touched by God's power.
- 23 Pray for the paid staff and clergy of Holy Trinity on a day away today. Pray also for our Wardens Martyn and Pat, as well as the deputy wardens helping on Sundays.
- 24 Pray for Arthur and Christine as they compile and edit Update every month. Pray for the rest of our publicity; the sign boards and inspiration for new ones, and for the website with Steve managing that. Pray also for those receiving GCSE results.
